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Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

for

Collaboration on Academic, Research and Community Healthcare Education

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Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding (this "MOU") made on this 12th day of February, 2021 between Shree Santkrupa College of Pharmacy, Ghogaon, Karad, (hereinafter referred to as "SSCOP") and Primary Health Center, Undale (hereinafter referred to as "PHCU"). The SSCOP and PHCU, collectively referred to as the "Institutions" or the "Parties",

RECOGNIZING their mutual interest in education, research, development and rural health education and care on a non-commercial basis, and also

RECOGNIZING the global nature of today's norms, industrial and social problems, and the need to address them through mutual cooperation,

HEREBY agree to encourage collaboration according to the terms and conditions set forth in the following articles.

Article 1: Fields of Collaboration

SSCOP and PHCU may collaborate within any mutually agreeable field of education research, and rural health education and care.

Article 2: Exchange of Faculty, Research Scholars and Students



- SSCOP and PHCU will encourage collaboration in education research and rural health care in areas of mutual interest, through reciprocal arrangements for faculty and research scholar exchanges.
- As feasible, and contingent upon cognizant parent organization or departmental approval, the administrations of the two institutions agree to assist their respective faculty members in developing scholarly exchanges that may include a range of interactions such as research collaboration, specialized lectures, seminars, teaching or submission of joint research proposals and arranging health awareness and or Health Check-up camps in rural parts of Karad Taluka.
- Both parties must agree upon the specific terms of any inter-institution initiative relative to this agreement in written or electronically recorded correspondence at least three months prior (???) to the initiation of a particular program or activity in order for the said initiative to proceed.
- Each host institution, in the pre-visit agreement correspondence, will also coordinate support with the visiting institution for office space, library, laboratory and other privileges appropriate to the level and purpose of the visit, subject to the availability of resources.



Article 3: Research projects

Interested faculty of either institution may initiate joint research projects. Subject to available funding, the Parties will encourage research centers of their respective institutions to initiate and conduct collaborative projects consistent with the other terms and specifications of this agreement. Such joint research projects are to be the subject of definitive project agreements specific to each project and separate from this MOU.

The financial arrangement relating to each joint research project will be in accordance with the specific agreement covering each project.

Article 4: Intellectual Property, Inventions and Innovations

The terms with respect to title to and exploitation of intellectual property (including trademarks and service marks, copyrights, patents designs and confidential information on the subject of such intellectual property, inventions and innovations) will be negotiated on a project-by-project basis in the specific research project agreements referred to in *Article-3* and broadly governed by the IPR policy of both institutions. Information on research results and scientific materials (reports, articles, books) will be exchanged freely keeping in mind the mutually agreed provision of Intellectual Property Rights. All Intellectual Property solely conceived and/or developed by *PHCU* during the course of this Agreement shall be owned by *PHCU*.



All Intellectual Property solely conceived and/or developed by SSCOP during the course of this Agreement shall be owned by SSCOP.

Intellectual Property jointly conceived and/or developed by PHCU and SSCOP will be jointly owned by PHCU and SSCOP. For purposes of this Agreement, the term "Intellectual Property" shall mean any and all works and property including, but not limited to, all intellectual properties, ideas, inventions, concepts, products, improvements, innovations, discoveries, developments, methods, formulas, techniques, software, know- how and writings made, conceived, reduced to practice, developed, written, or prepared by a party, whether or not patentable or copyrightable and whether made solely by that party or jointly with other third parties. PHCU and SSCOP agree to collaborate towards the protection, if appropriate, and application of et. Runni, Dist. Solution such Intellectual Property for commercial or other purposes on mutually acceptable terms to be negotiated in good faith between the parties.

Article 5: Administration and General Provisions

- This MoU shall have an initial duration of five years from the date of signature, unless either party gives a six-month notice of termination. This MoU may be extended further, in five-year increments or by any other number as may be agreed upon mutually with a written agreement.
- Despite the statements and obligations expressed herein, this MoU is a nonbinding expression of the current intentions of the Parties, and neither Party will incur nor be bound to any legal obligations or expense hereunder to the other Party until and unless definitive agreements have been negotiated, approved by



the necessary management levels of each Party and executed and delivered by authorized representatives of both Parties.

This MoU is signed subject to approval by the appropriate authorities on both sides.

[hereinafter referred to as 'KVK'] and Shree Santkrupa Shikshana Sanstha's Shree Santkrupa College of Pharmacy, Ghogaon its registered office at Shree Santkrupa Shikshana Sanstha's campus, Karad - Ratnagiri Highway, Solapur- 415111, Maharashtra, India (hereinafter referred to as 'INSTITUTE') have mutual interest in collaborative extension and research work having application in the field of Scientific Agriculture, Medicinal Plant Cultivation, Value Addition to Agri Products and Pharmaceuticals on regular basis in an ongoing manner.

- A. The parties wish to record in this memorandum of understanding (MOU) the basis and principles concerning research work conducted jointly by Krishi Vigyan Kendra and Shri Santkrupa Shikshana Sanstha's Shree Santkrupa College of Pharmacy, Ghogaon.
- B. This MOU is not intended to be a binding agreement between the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof. A binding agreement will not occur unless and until the parties have negotiated, approved, executed and delivered an agreement. Until the execution and delivery of the agreement, either party shall have the absolute right to terminate all negotiations for any reason without liability hereof.

The KVK essentially being a Semi-governmental organization has necessary expertise and is basically interested in Agri Promotion and Extension Activities also in applied research resulting in product/process development for commercial exploitation (??). Aim of all such activities are directed at promoting good agricultural practices, improving economic status of farmers and also conserving water and soil using scientific methodologies.

The INSTITUTION on the other hand due to its strategic location and reputable existence over the years has enormous good will, interest, manpower and necessary complementary skills, infrastructure and technologies to exploit the agri / farm produce through value addition.

Both the organizations agree to the following guidelines for collaborative efforts for projects outlined in Annexure A.

2. CONTACTS:

The official contacts relative to this Memorandum of Understanding [MOU] are as listed below; however, contact between individual scientists and managers in both of organizations is encouraged as this will facilitate increasing collaboration.

3. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION:

Collaborations under this memorandum of understanding (MOU) may include, but are not limited to the following:

- 3.1. Service work provided by INSTITUTE for research performed either as KVK or INSTITUTE site;
- 3.2. Research contracts financed by KVK / INSTITUTE for research performed at KVK / INSTITUTE site and;
- 3.3. Joint research projects (funded/financed) by a third party submitted by both parties.
- 3.4. Promotion of Good Agricultural Practices (GAP) to produce exportable quality produce.
- 3.5. Encourage, motivate farmers to practice scientific and environment-friendly agriculture methodologies (any other suitable technical term ???) for economic prospects.
- 3.6. To provide platform to add value to the farm produce through processing.
- 3.7. To create awareness about national and international standards of quality for fruits, vegetables, medicinal plants and the products thereof.
- 3.8. To promote cultivation, value addition and maintain a sustainable supply of necessary raw materials to Ayurvedic manufacturers.

4. TEAM:

Both above mentioned parties will form a team consisting of working and consulting members from both members / employees / students / of both party constituents for collaborative work to be performed at INSTITUTE / KVK for research and development / extension of above mentioned projects and will appoint a Chief Investigator (hereinafter referred to as ***CI***) who will be appointed for each project before starting of project and will be added in **Annexure A** along with the title of the project with signature of both the official contacts mentioned in page 2, along with CI. Annexure A shall be appended as and when the projects are added.

4.1 RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 4.1.1. It is understood by both parties involved in the project that they will continue to fulfil their expected team responsibilities. Their objectives will be set in the regular meetings of above mentioned contracts including all personnel working under entitled projects, they will discuss how the project can be implemented and tasks will be designed thereafter by contacts. Any person found not to work efficiently, shall be liable for explanation to above mentioned contacts. Any further action necessary shall be taken by both contacts.
- 4.1.2 Team members from both parties will bear responsibility of non-disclosure of the above mentioned collaborative research, any person found guilty for disclosing project details shall be liable for action as set by both parties in nondisclosure agreements to be signed by all researchers to safeguard the intellectual property.

5. COMMUNICATION:

Above mentioned contacts from both parties will review the progress of their project with the collaborative team. Such meetings may be set up twice in a year or as necessary.

6. TIME:

- 6.1. Duration of the projects: Initial commitment to this MOU is estimated to be for a period of three years starting from the date of signing this agreement and projects will be assigned with this time-line. It may be renewed for further duration on existing or mutually acceptable terms.
- 6.2. Percentage/ Actual amount of time: INSTITUTE and KVK commit to effective implementation of regular monthly targets. It is understood and agreed upon that the working personnel will work on weekly schedule. Both parties will set and keep the account of this (working) time.
- 6.3. Meeting: It is understood that both INSTITUTE and KVK personnel involved in the project will continue to fulfil their expected team responsibilities and will furnish their commitments to compulsory meetings, conferences and events. Any potential conflicts regarding the execution of projects will be communicated at the earliest possible time to the contacts mentioned for every project and resolved amicably.

7. FINANCES:

- 7.1. The cost and expenses associated with each project shall be decided and addressed separately in a commercial agreement and may vary with nature of each project. The commercial terms agreed in the commercial agreement shall be acceptable and binding on both the parties for the project cost purpose.
- 7.2. The Institute shall reimburse the following expenses or provide in kind the following:
 - 7.2.1. All the materials and other consumables which may be required for executing the projects, charges incurred for tests undertaken at other laboratories, if any.
 - 7.2.2. Travelling allowance, dining allowance, hotel allowance for the travel of any team person regarding development of above mentioned projects. Reimbursement should be made within 30 days of receipt of said expense statement / claim by a member.
 - 7.2.3. Charges and fees for any third person / organization consulted for the development of above mentioned projects if mutually considered necessary.
 - 7.3.0. The Institute will incur all expenses and fees related to filing of patents undertaking searches and any litigation with respect to the filed patents.

8. OWNERSHIP:

Any intellectual property developed through this collaboration shall be assigned to the INSTUTUTE. The research workers and through them the institution shall continue to be named as the inventors. The inventors may include researchers who are employees of the INSTUTUTE in case they have contributed in developing the intellectual property. The detailed rights and conditions related to exercise of intellectual property ownership are further clarified below:

8.1. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY:

In the course of the conduct of the research or services required under contracts that may be developed, prior protected / non protected intellectual property (patents) of INSTITUTE may be utilized, new intellectual property (patents) may be developed and opportunity for synergic benefits from the combining of intellectual property envisioned. The following rights and responsibilities will pertain:

8.1.1. PRIOR INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY:

Intellectual property (patents) of INSTITUTE, protected or unprotected, that exists prior to the beginning of the joint effort that is utilized or disclosed as a part of the design or implementation of both these projects will remain the sole property of the INSTITUTE. Protection of prior intellectual property of INSTITUTE, which is being disclosed to KVK, will also become the responsibility of the KVK. The partner organization will maintain confidentiality of all such property and shall not use the information for any purpose other than those authorized in writing by the owner of intellectual property. However, wherever the KVK's services are employed for patent filling, sealing, protection of the know-how developed, INSTITUTE will automatically assign the know-how to KVK on a non-exclusive basis, the financial reimbursement for this assignment being the cost of the company assistance as above and the financial charges as mentioned in clause no 7 (finances). Additionally, a lump sum technology transfer charge to INSTITUTE may be considered on a case basis.

8.1.2. NEW INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY:

In instances where new intellectual property is anticipated as a result of the project (joint research projects) KVK will take all responsibility regarding filing, and processing of collaborative intellectual property (which includes all expenses for any pre grant or post or post grant oppositions). This intellectual property shall be jointly held and patented with the KVK as an applicant / assignee and researchers / institute named as inventors. Any further commercialization should be addressed in that specific contract before commencement of any research activities.

9. JOINT PROPOSALS FOR THIRD PARTY PROJECTS:

- 9.1. As mutually beneficial opportunity presents, KVK and INSTITUTE may elect to submit joint proposals to other (third party) clients for research or development of specific part of project or develop products according to their need for their commercial use. All such use of above mentioned joint project could be conducted. The joint working and division of responsibilities and sharing or rewards will be mutually finalized for each such project based upon individual contribution. Based upon the nature and content of the third party project, any one out of the company and institute shall become the principle service provider and the other subsidiary provider to the third party. In general, for all financial arrangements & agreements made with third parties for generating technology resulting from projects basically initiated by the INSTITUTE & commercialized, the share of the benefits between KVK & INSTITUTE will be as mutually agreed at the time of the agreement.
- 9.2. The equipment and instrument purchased from the finance generated from the third party shall be the sole property of the INSTITUTE.

10. CONFIDENTIALITY:

10.1. PROPRIETARY BUSINESS INFORMATION:

Each organization acknowledges and agrees that its fellow collaborator is engaged in service, research activities in which it is or may be crucial to develop and retain proprietary, trade secrets, and other confidential information for the benefit of the both organization (collectively, "Proprietary Information"). Accordingly, no organization shall at any time during or after the termination of this MOU, either directly-

- 10.1.1. Divulge or convey proprietary information to any entity or individual, except as may be expressly authorized in writing by its fellow organization during or following the completion of the contractual relationship; or
- 10.1.2. Use any proprietary information for the organization's own benefit or the benefit of any entity or individual other than the organization owning the proprietary information. The proprietary information to which the collaborating organization may have access may include, but is not limited to, matters of a technical or intellectual nature such as inventions, designs, drawings, models, plans, improvements, processes of discovery, techniques, methods, ideas, discoveries, developmenta, know-how, formulae, compounds, compositions, specifications, specialized knowledge. The owner of such proprietary information shall mark all documents, it considers covered by the clause as confidential before providing them to its collaborator. Regardless of whether the information supplied pursuant to the said purpose is marked confidential or not, if the same falls within the above mentioned definition, it will be deemed to be proprietary information.

Proprietary Information will be transmitted "as is" and with all its faults, provided that in no event shall company be liable for the accuracy or completeness of the proprietary information.

10.2. PROPRIETARY PERSONAL INFORMATION:

During course of the collaborations, either entity may have access to private and personal information regarding their partners, customers, management, and shareholders, including, but not limited to, information regarding their personal, legal, or business affairs. KVK and INSTITUTE understand and agree that the disclosure of any information whatsoever regarding the partner could be damaging. Each institution therefore agrees not to disclose any such information to any person entity including the media during or after the term of this MOU, except as required for the purposes of fulfilling the requirements of specific collaborations or as expressly authorized by the partner institution in writing, or as required by law.

11. APPLICABILITY OF THE MOU TO EMPLOYEES OF THE ORGANIZATIONS:

12.1. The MOU will come into effect on the day on which it is signed.12.2. The term of the MOU will be three years from the effective date.

13. AMENDMENT:

This MOU may be amended by mutual consent of both the parties.

14. TERMS & CONDITIONS:

This MOU shall continue in full force and effect for a period of three years from the date of signing and can be terminated by either party by giving *one (1) months prior notice* to the other party. The INSTITUTE will not enter into an agreement with /or share the research work undertaken by this MOU with any third party without prior permission of the KVK. In case, the INSTITUTE wishes to share or disclose the information with any third party, it can be done only after making good the loss suffered by the KVK in this behalf.

15. OBLIGATIONS OF THE COMPANY:

The KVK obtains and keeps valid all applicable authorized, consents, approvals, licenses, and clearance that are necessary for the performance of its obligations set out in this MOU. The

INSTITUTE will be responsible for the quality parameters of the products or for its ill effects including for claims and damages.

AND

Rubicon Skill Development Private Limited a Company incorporated and registered under the Companies Act, 2013, having its Corporate office at 9th Floor, Tower 1, Fountainhead, Nagar Road, Vimannagar, Pune - 411014, Maharashtra, hereinafter referred to as "Rubicon" (which term shall so far as the context admits be deemed to mean and include its successors, administrators, executors and assignees) of the Second Part.

1. Introduction

THE COLLEGE has decided to partner with RUBICON for the conduct of Connect with Work Program (hereinafter referred to as "Training Program") at THE COLLEGE.

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2. THE COLLEGE Responsibilities:

- 2.1. Shall nominate one person with adequate accountability and responsibility to coordinate the Training Program. He / She would act as the single point of contact for the proposed Training Program.
- 2.2.Shall make available the infrastructure (including IT infrastructure, applications and connectivity) required to conduct the Training Program.
- 2.3. Shall provide all the support services and facilities to RUBICON during the conduct of the said Training Program. Adequate power backup through UPS and DG supplies during the training sessions
- 2.4. Shall coordinate with RUBICON and facilitate conduct of all the assessments including the assessment to be conducted by the external agency (if any) identified by RUBICON, as per schedule communicated by RUBICON.
- 2.5. Provide lodging, wherever available, as per the standards of RUBICON for faculty conducting the Training Programme for the total duration of the Training Program plus two days (one day prior and one day after closure). The lodging so planned to be provided should be with independent room (with attached toilet), regular water supply, clean, with access to boarding facilities, should have well lit approach and surroundings, have adequate safety & protection and peaceful environment.
- 2.6. Shall share the details of students in a prescribed format to ensure that there is no duplication of student data.
- 2.7. This is a multi-year program to create social impact. The college shall share few details to assess the impact of the program. For e.g. Placement details of trained students will be required to assess the impact of the program from one year to another year.

3. RUBICON Responsibilities:

3.1. Will provide necessary training as per Training Program requirements and curriculum for delivery as per Annexure I to this MOU

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- 3.2. Will provide suitable faculties for the training exclusive for classroom training/virtual training
 - 3.3. Will conduct assessment of its own and also arrange external assessment as required.

4. Other Terms & Conditions:

The following are other terms and conditions of engagement:

4.1. Batch Size: The batch size would need to be a min of 35 students and max of 50

students or as mutually agreed.

4.2. Each student would be made available for the Training Program for specified number of

hours per day for the duration of the Training Program

- 4.3. Pre-assessment & Selection: RUBICON may carry out pre-assessment of the students who have applied for the course and shortlist the select candidates to undergo the Training Program. The final decision on selection of candidates eligible to take the Training Program shall be with RUBICON.
 - 4.4. Training Program schedule:

4.4.1.Training Program scheduled commencement date is 20 Dec 2021

4.5. Commercials:

4.5.1. Training Fees: The training Fees is as follows,

Since this is a CSR funded Program there is no fee payable by THE COLLEGE for this Training Program

4.5.2. Payment Terms Not Applicable

4.6. Certification:

Students who are successful in the assessment conducted by RUBICON shall be awarded a certificate post completion of the training program.

4.7. Term of engagement:

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This MoU is valid from the date the MOU is made for a period of 3 (Three) years, however both parties agree that based on mutual agreement, the terms may be extended. Both parties also agree that terms may be renegotiated.

4.8. Limitations and Warranties :

Both parties agree that it would be their endeavour to prevent any liability arising out of default or non-compliance of the MoU terms by the other party.

- 4.9. Termination:
 - 4.9.1. Both parties can terminate the MoU with a prior written thirty (30) day notice on default of terms of non-adherence to any condition or responsibilities by the other party as outlined in this MoU in case such default is not rectified within such 30 days.
 - 4.9.2. Each party shall be at liberty to terminate this MOU with a written notice period of 3 (three) months to the other party without any compensation and seeking legal redress.
- 4.9.3. Both parties also agree that it would be their professional endeavour that despite any termination of the MOU, progress would continue, without any prejudice to the ongoing Training Program, which would be without any hindrance and would be progressed for completion.

5. General Terms:

- 5.1. Both the parties may receive information proprietary to other party (the Confidential Information) in the course of performance of their obligations under this MOU. Confidential Information is not meant to include any information which (a) is publicly available (b) is rightfully received by the parties from third parties without accompanying secrecy obligations; (c) is already in either party's possession and was lawfully received from sources other than the parties or (d) is independently developed by the parties. The two bodies understand and acknowledge that the Confidential Information is valuable and confidential and agrees that it will at all times be kept in trust to be disclosed only to such persons as have a "need to know" the same for the effective implementation of this MOU and that it will only be used by the parties for the benefit of others.
- 5.2. Both the parties understand and agree that all written or other tangible data and documentation developed or procured by the other party in performing its obligations

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under this MOU, whether in printed or electronic form, belongs to other party and that other party will have all rights, titles and interests therein.

5.3. Both parties shall not use the name and brand of other party in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other. However RUBICON will have the right to use the testimonials/stories/case studies of students/College/University who have been the part of the Training Program for promoting the Connect with Work Program.

6. Jurisdiction:

In the event of any litigation, the court of jurisdiction shall be Pune.

7. Indemnification

Both parties agree to indemnify each other and hold the other party harmless from and against any claim, loss, liability, or expense, including, but not limited to, damages, patent, and trademark infringement, costs and attorneys' fees, arising out of or in connection with any acts or omissions of their agents or employees, as related to the terms of this MoU.

Any claim, compensation, case initiated by any student against RUBICON/CSR DONOR in relation to the Training Program due to any acts or omissions of THE COLLEGE, RUBICON shall be defended and contested by THE COLLEGE at their sole expenses and cost keeping RUBICON/CSR DONOR indemnified from the same.

8. Limitation of Liability:

Except for the indemnification obligations, both parties agree that the liability would be limited to the amount of actual transactions between the two parties

9. Notices:

Any notices under this MOU will be sent by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, to the respective address of Parties as contained in this MOU. Such notice will be effective upon its mailing as specified.

10. Intellectual Property Rights

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- 10.1. RUBICON explicitly warrants that it owns all the intellectual properties related to content in all formats, the technology framework and all other related objects and the THE COLLEGE has no rights to use the content and mode of delivery for any other purpose.
 - 10.2. Each party hereby undertakes to inform the other party of any violation of Intellectual Property Rights or its unlawful use, under prevalent laws of India Further, each of the party herein, agrees to co-operate with the other to the extent possible in the process of investigating such cases of any violation of Intellectual Property Rights or its unlawful use and taking legal action against the said infringement.
 - 10.3. Upon expiration of this MoU, or two years period of time from the date of completion of the courses, whichever is later, each party hereby agrees that it shall not make any claim on the Trade Name or the copyrights of the other, which belongs exclusively to the other party, nor shall either party use any trade name which is deceptively or confusingly similar to the trade name of the other.

11. Force Majeure:

- 11.1. Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfil and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.
 - 11.2. Any extraordinary event, which cannot be controlled by the parties, shall for the purpose of this MOU be considered as a Force Majeure event. Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority. Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions
