- Each host institution, in the pre-visit agreement correspondence, will also coordinate support with the visiting institution laboratory and other privileges appropriate to the level and purpose of the visit, subject to the availability of resources.

- OLCC will provide awareness lecture, Oral, Breast & physical checkup
- There should be minimum 20 Females per camp.
- Charges for Awareness Lecture 1500/-
- Pap Smear 350/- per female
- Patient attending camp would be given discount on investigation at Onco Life Cancer Centre.
